

The CFAC sub-committee reviewing funding methodologies for the proposed Town Clean Water Protection program will be hosting a public hearing on January 11th, 2010 at 7 P.M. at Town Hall. This is a town-wide issue and all interested citizens are encouraged to attend.

The purpose of the meeting is to allow the public to share with the committee their ideas on funding methods and to offer suggestions with respect to the sub-committee's fact finding process. The sub-committee will not be making a presentation at this time and is desirous of hearing funding ideas or concepts for its consideration.

The session will be moderated by Rob Sennett. Depending upon the turnout, the sub-committee may be obligated to limit the amount of time for each speaker. Finally, while the sub-committee acknowledges the fact that issues of science and technology may have a significant impact upon the cost of the proposed program; it will attempt to keep the focus of the meeting and any comments on the issue of funding methodologies.
